The entire Territorial Aggregate Program has been revamped.

There are:

Seven Rifle aggregates, including a Senior's Aggregate (if over 60 years old).

Four Ladies aggregates, including a Ladies Hunter Aggregate.

Four Youth (under 21) aggregates, including a Youth Hunter Aggregate.

Three Bench aggregates, including a Hunter Bench Aggregate.

Three Handgun aggregates, including a Pistol Hunter Aggregate.

New this year: *Aggregate E: Rifle Frolic Championship Aggregate:*

One traditional flintlock or percussion rifle, Offhand, five shots each target

SIGHTS: Fixed & Open. NO spotting scopes, sighters, or sight adjustments

Adjustable rear sights will be taped (black electrical tape) to be "Fixed".

Targets at 25 yd, 50 yd, & 100yd,

Clarifications:

"AMS" : Any Metallic Sight: Fixed or Adjustable, Open or Peep Sights, Hoods permitted, but no Scopes.

"Any/Scope": AMS, Hoods Permitted or Scope.

"Open Sights": Fixed or Adjustable. Hoods not permitted

"Fixed Open Sights" Adjustable Sights allowed, but electrician's tape will be placed over the elevation and windage screws to disallow adjustment.

Aggregate J. Pistol Championship Agg: Match J42: Limited Time Fire: LTF:

If a C&B revolver is used in this Match within the Aggregate, it must be loaded and fired as a single-shot pistol in J42, i.e., only one chamber loaded (Not 'cylinder' as printed in the program).

Course of fire for Match J42: Two (2) five-minute strings, consisting of five (5) shots per string. Time for each string to start with competitor's first shot exiting the barrel. Both strings must be completed in the same relay.

Please ignore Registration & Aggregate Fees shown printed at top of Page 1 of the Aggregate Shoot Program. Just follow the guidelines in this cover letter.

A competitor joining the NMLRA at the registration desk can get the annual digital membership for \$ 50.00, and qualify for the discounted \$15.00 rate for registration and aggregate fees. This works great for competitors attending more than one Territorial Championship.

For the benefit of our competitors, our club elected to give up the potential income of \$ 5.00 for each registration fee and \$5.00 each aggregate, which could amount to be \$200 or more, a bit of a loss for us, but we hope folks will support us by attending and participating at the Territorial Marches.
